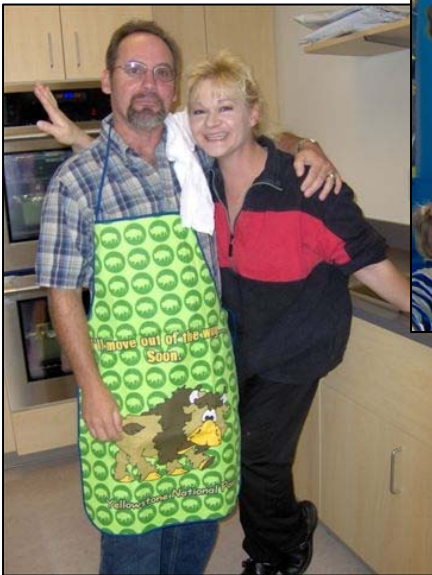

### Holy Wash: Sept. 28 -

**Liturgical Tidbits: Receiving the Sacred Body and the Sacred Blood:** Although we believe that Christ is truly and totally present in both the consecrated bread and the consecrated wine, the fullness of the sign is receiving both. Christ said, "Take and eat," and "Take and drink." The General Instruction of the Roman Missal states: "The sign of communion is more complete when given under both kinds, since in that form the sign of the eucharistic meal appears more clearly. The intention of Christ that the new and eternal covenant be ratified in his blood is better expressed, as is the relation of the eucharistic banquet to the heavenly banquet."
